Readings: 2 Peter 1:1-11

Everything we need for a godly life

Christians in Peter's day like us, in our day, were struggling to keep faith in the face of all their critics, false teachers and scoffers. So Peter writes this, his last letter shortly before his death 1:12-14 to "refresh our memories" v13, and to ensure we remain "firmly established in the truth" v12.

The theme he develops is that our God and Saviour Jesus Christ has given us **everything we need** to know Him, and to grow in Him and live a godly life for Him in a world that hates and despises Him. So **"make every effort"** 1:5, 1:10, 3:14 to go on growing in Jesus because He has given you everything you need.

HE HAS GIVEN YOU HIS VERY GREAT AND PRECIOUS PROMISES 1:3-4

What are the purposes of the promises we make to others? (E.g. Wedding Vows)

Here are the two purposes God gives us His precious promises:

1. To escape the world's corruption, caused by (epithymia) v4b

G K Chesterton: "Dear sir, the problem with the world is me"

2. To make you like the promise Giver v4a

John G Paton: During the crisis, I felt generally calm, and firm of soul, standing upright and with my whole weight on the promise, **'Lo! I am with you always.'** Precious promise! How often I adore Jesus for it, and rejoice in it! Blessed be his Name

WE HAVE EVERYTHING WE NEED TO MAKE EVERY EFFORT TO BE LIKE JESUS 1:5-11

Because....

1. Your sustained effort of addition (5-7) leads to LOVE
2. Which avoids the dangers of wasting your Christian life (8-9)
3. And empowers you to stand and confirms your assurance that you are a true and precious child of God (10-11)
